

Looking back...

- **909** Richard Schirmann, a German school teacher, leveloped the idea of a network of Youth Hostels in Sermany.
- 912 The first Youth Hostel, Altena Castle in Germany, was stablished.
- 919 the German Youth Hostel Association was founded.
- 932 the first IYHF International Youth Hostel Conference vas held in Amsterdam, Netherlands.

Over 4,700 Youth Hostels in 5 continents


Has over 330,000 beds

Publicity Materials....


A variety of publicity materials were produced, including brochures, booklets and information cards. All with the aim of raising awareness of the initiative.

15-19July 2004, Seoul, South Korea....

347 young people from 27 nations worked collectively for 5 days around the main themes of Culture, Peace and Environment
