
## Uganda, a very brief history....

#### Founded in Kampala in 1998

- ★ 50 seasons, various sports
- Supported by 140 commercial sponsors, 13,000 boys & girls & 2,000 Adult Vols
- Teams Diverse & Inclusive
  - In school/out of school
  - Religious background
  - Different social/economic backgrounds
  - All skills
  - Co-ed, age 4-15
- KKL won 4 World Youth Cups
- Role models, WHO Measles

- Peace 2006/7?








### The Problem......

- Prolonged 'trauma'








# The Kids League (TKL).....



- Abducted 2003 by rebels
- Over 1 Year in bush
- Trained to be a soldier
- Witnessed & committed atrocities
- Escaped in 2005
- Friendless, idleness, loneliness
- Joined TKL; walks 10 km to play
- scored goal; hugged for the first time in his life






### Case Histories & Stories 3...

- Drew Sad/Now Happy drawings








### Case Histories & Stories 4...




## TKL Karamoja 2007.....
