Executive Secretary of U.N. ESCAP to be Keynote Speaker at 3rd Global Summit



Dr. Kim Hak Su, Executive Secretary of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (ESCAP) will be a featured Keynote Speaker at the 3rd Global Summit on Peace through Tourism being held October 2-5, 2005 at the award winning Royal Cliff Beach Resort and Conference Center, Pattaya, Thailand.

Dr. Kim, a national of the Republic of Korea, is a prominent economist with vast experience in central banking, development planning, government thinktanks, international organizations, and private sector management. He has been an economist with the Bank of Korea, Republic of Korea's central bank; President of Daewoo Corporation; President of the Hanil Banking Institute; and Secretary-General of the Colombo Plan, where he revitalized the 24-member country intergovernment Colombo Plan in Asia and the Pacific, stressing human resource development and focusing on South-South cooperation.

Other Keynote Speakers will include world leaders, Ministers of Tourism, travel industry statesmen, and leaders in related sectors such as environment, culture, sport, and sustainable economic development.
